Regular flights are available from all Australian capital cities to Green Island via Cairns. Great Adventures operates high-speed catamaran (45 minutes) transfers between Cairns and Green Island three times a day. These transfers are complimentary for resort guests and are confirmed at the time of booking. Helicopter and seaplane transfers from Cairns or Cairns International Airport are also available
