Hamilton Island

Whether you're looking for action, relaxation, romance or a fun family getaway, it's all here in abundance, with new experiences and adventures waiting around every corner.

Activities

Discover the picturesque waterways in a private dinghy or sail the day away on board a luxury yacht, stopping off at Whitehaven Beach, renowned for the dazzling perfection of its white sand. Style of accommodation

Hamilton Island offers a variety of accommodation types, ranging from 3-star island-style garden bungalows, extremely spacious 4-star hotel rooms, luxurious 5-star waterfront rooms and a wide range of 3 to 5-star self-catering properties spread throughout the island.

Hotels

Located resort side and in close proximity to Catseye Beach, the main pool and resort centre, the island's hotel accommodation includes the 3-star Palm Terrace and Palm Bungalows, the 3 1/2-star one-bedroom Whitsunday Holiday Apartments, the 4-star Reef View Hotel and the 5-star Beach Club. Perfect for guests looking for the convenience of hotel service.





Self-catering properties

The island's individual self-catering rental properties, including apartments and houses that sleep from one to eight people, are set in their own grounds, with most sharing landscaped gardens and a swimming pool. There are a variety of styles including studio, split level and two storey. All properties include a complimentary four-seat buggy. Four-night minimum stay applies.

Spa experience

Hamilton Island's Relaxation Centre offers a variety of holistic and massage therapies, ranging from aromatherapy, therapeutic and oriental head massages to rejuvenation, de-stress and "especially for him" body treatments. A pregnancy massage is provided for mums-to-be (three to six months gestation only) while other special modalities, including Thai, Kahuna, Lymphatic, Acupressure and Reiki, are available on a restricted basis.
